



#### STEP BY STEP

#### CHIGNON

It is a type of hairstyle worn for special occasions, such as weddings or gala events, but the base of the chignon is also used for everyday sports styles.

The first chignons date back to the era of Ancient Greece, where Athenian women commonly wore them, securing them with ivory or gold clasps.



Create a ponytail and twist it counter-clockwise upon itself.

Place the index and the middle fingers on the base of the ponytail and rotate it clockwise.

Roll it around the base, from right to left (clockwise) while keeping the twisted ponytail close to the base itself.

Rotate the twisted ponytail around the base, from right to left (clockwise).

Keep the ponytail close to the base itself.

Create a low placed ponytail and backcomb it.

Separate the ponytail into three sections.

Backcomb them lightly and wrap each section around the tease until it is covered, to completely hide it.

Continue to rotate it on itself until you run out of hair.

Hide the ends under the created "ball" and secure everything with hairpins by inserting them diagonally with respect to the direction of the hair.
